



We are excited to welcome delegates for our 79th session from Sunday, May 25, 2025 - Saturday, May 31, 2025 at Lipscomb University.

Registration for delegates is now open. Here are a few important notes:

We use an online registration system. You will receive an email directly from Campwise with instructions for your delegate(s) to go to our website and log into the portal, as well as a unique code, and your school's, ALA unit's, or AL Post's delegate allotment number. To ensure that you receive the email from Campwise, please add mail@alavgs.campwise.com to your email contact list. If you don't receive the note from Campwise with the link to our portal by Friday, Jan 24, contact kathy.isaacson@alavgs.org.

We have allocated spaces to ALA Units and AL Posts, and in some cases, directly to the high schools. In some cases, at your request, the email from Campwise is coming directly to you rather than to school counselors. If your unit sponsors delegates from more than one high school, you'll receive more than one email – one per high school. Each school has a distinct registration code. Simply pass along the email and appropriate high school code to each delegate. If you'd like to reallocate spaces among the high schools, just let us know. Once girls are registered, we can still help you get an all-inclusive invoice so you can make a single payment.

In other cases, the high school counselor has received the same email with space allocations and codes. We encourage you to communicate with those high school counselors to confirm the number of spaces you're willing to fund and details of funding.

As an American Legion Auxiliary or an American Legion sponsor, there's NO NEED for you to establish an account on Campwise. Once you choose your delegate(s), simply forward the email with the link and registration code (unique to each high school you sponsor) to each delegate. She will enter medical information, and she and her parents/guardians will sign legal release forms digitally. We encourage alternates to register as well. If you would like to do have your alternates register, please contact kathy.isaacson@alavgs.org. We will send you a unique code for your alternates.



As each delegate completes registration, she will be emailed a confirmation along with an invoice that will show “\$0.00” as her balance due. The invoice with the actual balance due will come to you as the sponsor or to the high school. If you sponsor a number of high schools and you are receiving the email and allocation for a large number of spaces, you’ll receive multiple invoices with the balance due. If you’d prefer to wait until all your delegates are registered to send a single payment, please contact us. We can send you a single invoice with your grand total. Your organization may pay by credit card, for a small fee. If you’d like to send us a check, see below.

Please include the name of your ALA Unit or AL Post on the check or in an accompanying note. It also helps us if you remind us of the high school/s you sponsor either on the check or in a note.

Fees are due by April 25. The fee is \$500 per delegate.

Each delegate must commit to participate the entire week.

Once paid, that fee is **non-refundable**. If a delegate needs to cancel, please fill her space with an alternate.

Registration will close on April 25.

After that date, spaces are no longer reserved unless you’ve communicated with me. We’ll start filling spaces from our waiting list and alternate list.
